How we help children, youth, and families

We are a nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting children, youth, and families in difficult life situations. For over 50 years, we have been offering a variety of services to help those in need.



Jugendhaus (Youth House)

Our "Jugendhaus" offers teenagers who cannot grow up with their families a loving home with a structured daily routine, educational and vocational support, and meaningful leisure activities.



Familienhilfzentrum (Family Support Center)

In our "Familienhilfzentrum", we help children, teenagers, and families affected by violence, neglect, or sexual violence. We are available around the clock and offer both in-person counseling and online support.



Elternladen (Parent Support Center)

In our "Elternladen" expectant parents and families receive support. Through open offerings available to everyone, parents can connect, empathize, and share their experiences.



Lautrer Betreutes Einzelwohnen (Assisted Independent Living)

Adolescents and young adults on their path to independence are individually supported by educational professionals.



Lautrer Careleaver Zentrum (Lautrer Care Leaver Center)

Former recipients of child and youth welfare services – whether they were supported by SOS-Kinderdorf Kaiserslautern or another organization – can find advice and support at the "Lautrer Careleaver Zentrum".



Tagesgruppe (Day Group)

Our "Tagesgruppe" supports families under significant stress in their daily lives: Children aged 6 to 12 are cared for during the day and receive individualized support. Families also receive tailored assistance based on their needs.



Spielertreff (Play Center)

Young children, especially those from refugee families, attend our "Spielertreff". Here, the children's emotional and motor development is supported, providing relief from the stresses of everyday family life.



Eltern-Kind-Treff (Parent-Child-Center)

Our "Eltern-Kind-Treff" offers low-threshold, open services for overwhelmed families in socially disadvantaged areas. Here, they can connect with others and enjoy carefree moments with their children.



Kitasozialarbeit (Preschool Social Work)

Our social workers provide guidance to daycare centers, serve as contact persons for parents, and plan activities and programs for children and families within the community.



Schulsozialarbeit (School Social Work)

Our social workers support students with academic and personal challenges. They also assist teachers and provide guidance to parents.



Familien- und Bildungszentren (Family and Education Centers)

Our Familien- und Bildungszentren provide free services to support families in their daily (school) life and complements the work of schools and school social services.

On-site where help is needed

More than 70 full-time employees and many dedicated volunteers work at over 18 locations in the Kaiserslautern area every day to support children, young people, and families.

Some of our services can only be provided with the help of donations. They are low-threshold, diverse, and always free of charge for all those we support. Thanks to the financial support of foundations, companies, and private individuals, we are able to strengthen children, young people, and families in difficult life situations over the long term and open up new perspectives for them.
